REALTOR® Safety Tips

We continue with more safety tips to help keep agents safe during their everyday business:

Tip #29: Nothing Personal.... When talking to clients and prospects, be friendly but still keep your personal information private. This means avoiding mention of where you live, your after-work or vacation plans, and similar details.

Tip #30: Take two seconds as you walk towards your destination to check out potential risks. Are people coming and going or is the area unusually quiet? Do you observe any obstacles or hiding places in the parking lot or along the street? Is anyone loitering in the area?

Tip #31: Be careful with keys Don't hand out house keys to friends, even if they are trustworthy. Know the location of all your house keys all the time. Never use hide-a-keys or leave the key under the doormat, above the door, in a flowerpot, or anywhere outside the house. You may think you're being clever, but experienced thieves know all the tricks. Also, keep your car keys and house keys on a different ring if you ever use valet parking or leave your keys with parking lot attendants or even at a repair garage.

Tip #32: From dawn till dusk When showing a vacant commercial site, be aware of the time of day you meet a client. Showing a property at dusk or after dark, with no electricity on in the space you are showing, is not advisable.


4 Tips to Keep You Safe During REALTOR® Safety Month (and Beyond!)

When you're at the office, use a visitor log book and have each potential client fill out a customer identification form. Remember to also check their photo ID.

Keep your business separate from your personal life online. Set up separate personal and business accounts on Facebook, Twitter or any social media sites. This will help protect your personal photos, posts, and other information from access by people you don't know.

When showing a property, leave the front door unlocked for a quick exit while you and the client are inside. And, as you view each room, let the client enter first.


Be aware of and use the 10 second rule. Take 10 seconds as you arrive at each of your destinations to evaluate your surroundings and check for anything out of the ordinary.



Enable Agent Safety Today

Agent Safety is a feature included in the SentriKey Real Estate app. To enable the feature, follow these simple steps:

- 1 Open the SentriKey Real Estate app
- At the top left, tap the menu > My Settings > Agent Safety > Enable Agent Safety
- 3 Accept the Release Agreement
- Enter your four-digit PIN or use Touch ID or Face ID to confirm identity
- To allow access to your contacts, tap + (next to Safety Notification Contacts) and select **OK**
- 6 Select at least one contact from the list
- 7 Tap Continue to cycle through confirmations














Charity Auction Dinner Ticket and Table Reservation Information

Did you know about Homesnap Pro's Safety Timer?

Homesnap designed this easy-to-use feature specifically with agent safety in mind. Simply add your emergency contacts and set a timer for a specific length of time when you get to a showing. If you don't stop the timer before it goes off, your emergency contacts will get an alert. Or, simply stop the timer once you've left the property.

Open Homesnap: When you are within 2000 feet, view any property in Homesnap to set a Safety Timer.

Set Duration and Contacts: Tell Homesnap how long you expect to be at the location and select your emergency contacts.

Show The Listing: You can stop the timer or add time as you go. If the timer expires, a text message will be sent to your emergency contacts.

Issue an Instant Distress Alert: In case of distress, send a text message to your emergency contacts in one tap.



It's always good to let people know where you're headed, and this safety feature in the Homesnap Pro app lets you quickly and discreetly do that.


