#### NAR Code of Ethics—Cycle 7: Jan. 2022-Dec. 2024

REALTOR® Members - just a reminder that we are currently in cycle 7 for the NAR Code of Ethics requirement. REALTORS® are required to complete ethics training of not less than 2 hours, 30 minutes of instructional time. The training must meet specific learning objectives and criteria established by the National Association of REALTORS®.

There are many Code of Ethics training providers and many of you have taken a course through a school or CE sponsor. However, <u>we must receive a copy of</u> **your Certificate of completion in order to update your NAR record**. If a copy is not sent, we have no way of knowing that you have completed a course. If you have checked on the NAR website to view your Code of Ethics status and it shows that it is not completed, please send a copy of your COE certificate as soon as possible. If you have taken a course through LPCAR or NAR, your record will be updated automatically. New members who have taken our orientation class have also fulfilled the requirement. Please contact board office if you have questions.
