## 2026 Scholarship Information

LPCAR is pleased to offer Scholarships in the amount of \$1000 each, to area students who plan on pursuing further education after graduation or are currently attending a college or trade school and who are related to a REALTOR or Affiliate member of LPCAR. There will be **4 (four)** Scholarships available. Three will be available to any student related to an LPCAR member—REALTOR or Affiliate member, and one scholarship is available with the same criteria but with one additional requirement—the family member must have served on the board of directors—either in the past or a current board member. This is our Board of Director Service Scholarship! Eligible applicants may apply to both scholarships but may only be selected for one.



This award will be given to a person demonstrating outstanding community involvement who is planning to pursue further education through an accredited college, university, or trade school or are currently attending college or a trade school.

### Scholarship FAQs

1. **What is the eligibility criteria for the Scholarship?** To be eligible the student must be pursuing further education after graduation or must be currently enrolled in a college or trade school. Students must also be related to an LPCAR member—Affiliate of REALTOR—who is in active and in good standing. For our Board of Director Service Scholarship, the student must be related to a member who has served on the LPCAR board of directors—past or current and is a member in good standing.
2. **How does my student apply for the scholarship?** Applications are available for download on our website. Please make sure to provide the application to eligible students.
3. **What is the deadline for application submission?** The deadline to submit the application is April 30, 2026.
4. **How much money is awarded through the scholarship?** For 2026 each recipient will receive \$1000 for their further education costs.
5. **How many scholarships are awarded each year?** In 2026 there will be 4 (four) Scholarships available.
6. **How do I submit the application?** [Two copies must be sent to the board office via mail or may also be dropped off at the board office. \(please contact the office for drop off times/info\)](#)

The deadline for this year is **April 30, 2026**. Please make sure your student applies as soon as possible. The application also requires an essay of 200 words or less explaining why the scholarship should be awarded. Any application received without the essay will not be considered during the selection process. It is important for the student to complete all parts of the application

Please download the application and have your student complete and send the form back by the deadline. Students of family members of LPCAR are eligible for this scholarship so we encourage them to apply as soon as possible.

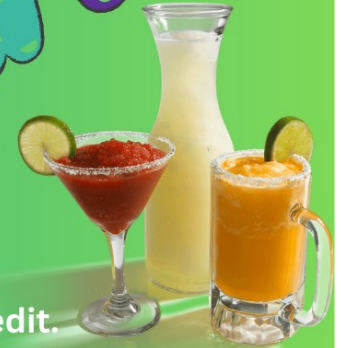

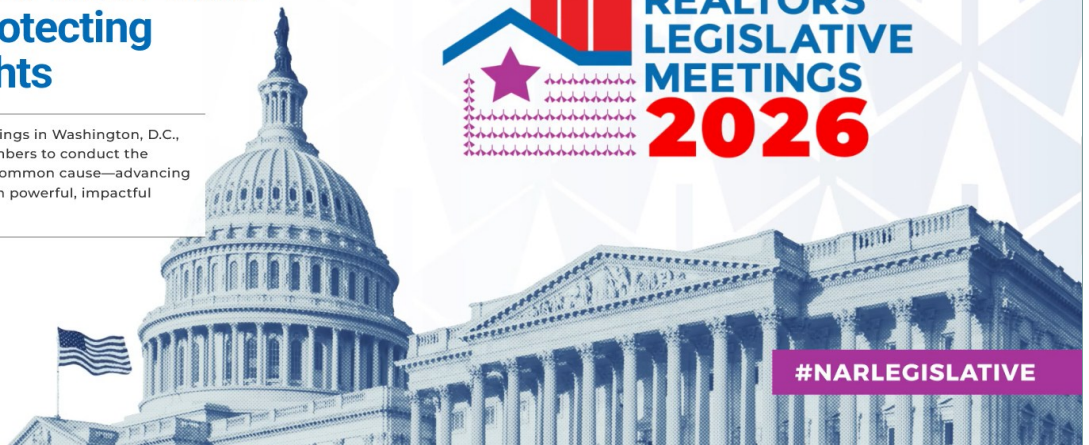

### Buyer Agency Violations

The State is beginning to hear reports of potential violations related to Buyer Agency practices in Indiana, and it is important to reinforce the legal requirements now in effect. As a reminder, under Indiana law (HEA 1068), effective July 1, 2024, real estate licensees must have a written Buyer Agency Agreement in place before providing agency services—including showing property or negotiating on behalf of a buyer.

These agreements must be in writing, include a definite expiration date, and a copy must be provided to the buyer within three business days. In addition, MLS rules implemented in connection with the 2024 NAR settlement require that buyer representation agreements be executed prior to touring homes and clearly disclose compensation terms. Failure to properly secure a signed agreement before engaging in these activities shall place a licensee in violation of both Indiana law and applicable MLS rules, creating potential legal and professional risk.
