Class begins at **10:00 a.m. CST**. CE is free of charge for all LPCAR members. \$20 for non-members.

Every licensed real estate broker must complete at least 12

hours per continuing education year of approved education courses. A continuing education year is defined as the one year period between July 1 of one calendar year and June 30 of the following calen-



dar year. (July 1, 2021-June 30, 2022 for the current cycle)

Need to check your CE courses?

Effective June 1, 2018 all Real Estate CE providers are required to submit their student's course completion information online. Licensee's may simply log into their Access Indiana Account (license renewal site) and view their CE courses. If you believe you are missing CE, please contact the provider/association that offered the continuing education course.

If you have taken any course through LPCAR and cannot find your certificate, please contact the office so we can issue you a copy.

REALTORS® Confidence Index

The REALTORS® Confidence Index (RCI) survey gathers on-the-ground information from REAL-TORS® based on their real estate transactions in the month. This report presents key results about market transactions.

Highlights

- While home buying demand is still outpacing supply, properties typically stayed on the market for 17 days (17 days in the prior month, 17 days one year ago).
- Eighty-eight percent of listings were on the market for less than one month (87% in the prior month, 88% one year ago).
- The first-time buyer market share edged lower to 28% (30% in the prior month; 31% one year ago).
- With some slow down in vacation home sales, the share of all-cash sales decreased to 26% (28% in the prior month, 25% one year ago).
- Intense competition lingers, and 25% of buyers waived an inspection contingency (23% in the prior month).

Code of Ethics Training—What you need to know in 2022

Existing REALTOR® members must complete 2.5 hours of ethics training, meeting specific learning objectives and criteria, within three-year cycles.

REALTORS® who have completed the required ethics training within a three-year cycle in one association shall not be required to complete any further ethics training for that same training cycle if the REALTOR® becomes or is a member of another association. Beginning January 1, 2022:

- Courses must include content on professional conduct, courtesies, business etiquette, and real-life scenarios.
- Only those courses and equivalencies provided by a local, state, or national REALTOR® association can satisfy the Code of Ethics training requirement. The Commitment to Excellence (C2EX) endorsement satisfies the requirement. Local associations may, however, partner with a third-party training provider to create a course that satisfies the requirement. A formal partnership means a local or state association of REALTORS® has vetted a provider (i.e. real estate school, Code of Ethics educators, etc.), and confirmed that the provider's course meets NAR's mandatory minimum criteria and learning objective requirements.

An association must accept a course for the Code of Ethics training requirement if a member completes the course through a provider that is <u>formally partnered with an association within the member's own state or a neighboring state</u>. If a course is taken from a partnered provider outside of those limits, it is up to each local association if they choose to accept it.

Many of you have begun to take a new Code of Ethics Course for this cycle. PLEASE verify that your course is approved PRIOR to taking the course. Any course taken through the NAR website, LPCAR or through an association within our state is automatically approved. Courses taken from other CE providers may or may not be approved so we recommend confirming.

Reminder: Code of Ethics can only be recorded on NAR through REALTOR Associations. Please send a copy of your certificate so we can update your record.

CE Reminder

All Indiana-licensed real estate Brokers must complete 12 hours of continuing education (CE) each year of the same 3 -year license renewal cycle.

Managing Brokers: Please remember that 4 of the 12 hours of CE you complete each year must be stateapproved Managing Broker curriculum.

Brokers newly licensed since July 1, 2014: You must complete a state-approved 30-hour Broker post-licensing course within 2 years of your license issue date. This course is required and satisfies your initial CE requirement during the first 2 years of licensure.
