The pandemic revealed just how important organized real estate is to our individual success. Indiana REALTORS® were able to keep working in the spring of 2020 because IAR worked for us. Our state association led a team to ask the governor to declare real estate an essential service, which he did. IAR also pushed for direct payments to landlords when their tenants qualified for housing assistance. **This was not the case in every state**. At the national level, if REALTORS® were not engaged on Capitol Hill, the provisions of the CARES Act may not have applied to us. We know the new Paycheck Protection Program, increased funding for SBA loans, and, for the first time ever, the extension of unemployment benefits to independent contractors helped REALTORS® weather the storm. These wins did not come from a quick call or text from our lobbyists. They came because of the relationships REALTORS® have built over

time AND because of your contributions to RPAC.




